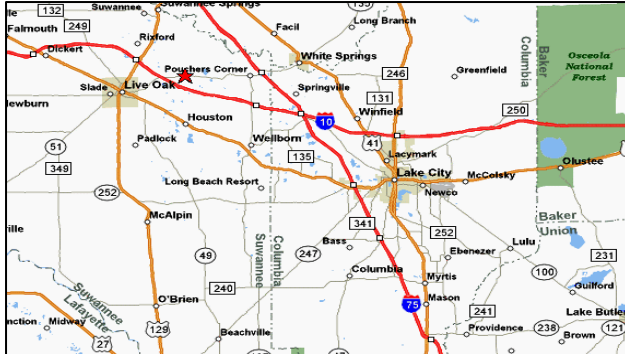

From Jacksonville: Take I-10 West to I-75 go north to County Road 136; go west on County Road 136 (Exit 439) approximately 6 miles to the facility. (The Center is on the left at the corner of CR 417 and CR 136).

From Gainesville or Valdosta: Take I-75 (north from Tampa/south from Valdosta) to the White Springs/Live Oak Exit (#439) (County Road 136); go west approximately 6 miles to the facility. (The Center is on the left at the corner of CR 417 and CR 136).
